



### **PRESS RELEASE - APRIL 2023**

The STUDENTS IN CLIMATE ACTION partnership implemented activities in the field of third (board game), fourth (teachers' training programme on climate change education) and fifth (reflection and assessment toolkit) output of the projects.

As a result of the third output, a board game was created, which is available on the project website. The board game aims not only to increase students' interest in the issue of climate change but most importantly impact their behavioral change and empower them to become climate change activists within their communities. The game, before uploading on the website, was tested in schools and then presented inter alia during the 21st Pancyprian Scientific Conference organized in Cyprus.

As a result of the fourth output there has been prepared teachers' training programme on climate change education, which elements have been tested during a face to face "teachers training seminar" organised by ZERO in Lisbon. There also has been prepared a handbook for teachers. Work was also underway on preparing our MOOC, a free online course for teachers on climate change education. It will be available soon on our website.

#### **Further activities**

As part of the fifth outcome (reflection and evaluation toolkit), opinions and comments will be collected and summarized based on a relevant questionnaire.

On May 29 will be held a Transnational Project Meeting, and the following day Final Dissemination Conference: "Educating change, Why and how to teach about climate change?", both events in Krakow, at Pedagogical University.
